



FamilySearch Registration and Settings

Go to familysearch.org to register for a free account.



Fill out the information about yourself. Your membership number can be obtained from the ward clerk, back of your temple recommend, or your phone under “LDS TOOLS” app. Answer “No” to the question “Are you a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints?”, if you are not a member and they will ask for a birthdate instead of a membership number. They will send you email confirmation, and then you are ready to start. You will then want to go into your settings located under your name and go into the 5 tabs below.



ACCOUNT You will need to sign up with a Username and Password which you will sign in with every time you go into FamilySearch. You can see your membership number. The “Helper Number” is what you give someone if you want them to get into your tree and possibly make changes. Or you would get someone else’s Helper Number if you are helping them.
