

## RECORDS FOUND IN PRINTED SOURCES

### Background

The Salt Lake City, Genealogical Library's catalog as well as published archive inventories identify records that have been microfilmed or which are currently found in archives. Additional printed sources can identify records that have been published in periodicals and books. These sources include *Der Schlüssel*, *Quellenschau für Familienforscher*, and the *Familiengeschichtliche Quellen*. The following is a brief description of each and how they may be accessed.

*Der Schlüssel* Göttingen: Heinz Reise Verlag, 1986 Volumes 1-9 (943 - D25sc). Translated, it means "the key".

This is currently a nine volume work. The format in volumes 1-3 has locality, subject and author/title indexes after each periodical they index. Volumes 4-9 have one locality, one subject and one author/title index for all of the periodicals they index. Every article or separate periodical item such as book review or opportunity find (Gelegenheitsfund) is listed alphabetically by author or compiler and then numbered consecutively. The indexes then list the numbers for each locality, subject and surname. In many cases articles contain extracts of records, compiled family histories or instructions for using records to resolve research problems. The following example is taken from volume seven:

The above entries would be indexed under the authors' name (Heil, Heiligbrunner and Heimann), under the localities of Butzbach, Hessen, Amerika and Alpenrod and under the subjects of Bürgermeister (mayors), Auswanderer (emigrants), Hirtenfamilien (sheepherder families) and Lehrer (teachers). A comma is given at the end of each article title and is followed by the year the article was published and the page(s) on which the article is found. The name of the periodical is given at the top of the page. With this information it is then possible to find many of these references at the Salt Lake Genealogical Library.

*Die Quellenschau für Familienforscher*. Köln a/Rhein: Paul Kuschbert Verlag, 1938 volumes 1-3 (943 - A3kp, film #924491, items 4-6). Translated it means "the display of sources for family research". The three volumes make up two sets of indexed sources. Volume one is part one of the first set which contains "Orts" (locality), "Gebiets" (area), "Sach" (subject) and "Personen" (surname) indexes. Volume two is part two of the first set which contains the 1,000 sources that were indexed. Volume three has the four indexes in the front of the book and a different 1,000 sources in the back. More than half of both sets are indexes to German periodicals. A complete explanation on the use of this printed resource is found in the *German Genealogical Digest*, 1989, fourth quarter, pp. 142-148. In the following example, reference

number "508/a" is given for the town of Jaaselmühle:

The source gives the name of the German periodical in which it is found. Below this is the volume and year the article was published. The title of the article is given next, followed by the issues of that year which pertain to the article. In this case twelve issues contain the names of all the serfs from every district in the principality of Lüneburg for the years 1563/64.

*Familiengeschichtliche Quellen*. Düsseldorf: Franz Heinzmann Verlag, 1994 volumes 1,3-19 (943 - B2fq, volumes 1,3-13 microfiche 6000817).

Each volume of this printed resource contains a surname index only. In an article in the *German Genealogical Digest*, 1990 4th quarter, pp. 140-144, a partial locality index is provided for volumes 1, 3-14 and 16. At the beginning of each book, the compiler list the sources that are indexed for that volume. Each source is given a consecutive number. The surname index in these books are not an author/title index but a complete index of every name found in the sources that are listed. The numbers given after the surname refer back to the sources listed at the front of the book and lets you know the source in which the name was found. Some numbers after surnames are followed by an additional number in parenthesis. This number, is the page number in the source being indexed. It is given only when the source itself is not indexed. The following example is from volume 19:

The above reference shows that the surname "*Draba*" is on page 26 of source #34. The source is a book containing a list of master and apprentice barrel makers, published at Hamburg in 1983 by Guenther Hamel.

Researchers who are not proficient in the German language, often feel incapable of tracing their German ancestral lines. Most of them are not aware of the numerous printed sources and special compiled genealogies that are available. Although these sources are written in German, they are indexed and are not too difficult to use. Researchers still need to use a good German-English dictionary and need to develop a working knowledge of the German language. The following are some of the more important of these sources and compilations:
