Viewed by the English in Pennsylvania - Very Surly People

Viewed by the English and Irish in Maryland and Virginia - Skilled Craftsmen, A People that made the economy flourish wherever they settled.

(1709 = 57 bakers, 124 carpenters, 69 shoemakers, 99 tailors, 29 butchers, 45 millers, 14 tanners, barbers, weavers, locksmiths, glassblowers, wool/linen weavers, blacksmiths etc.)

Viewed along the Great Wagon Road (Pennsylvania south to Carolinas) - There were no better innkeepers.

Hessen soldiers (29,867 - 4,626 killed = 25,241, 12,554 remained)

Civil War = 1/10 of the soldiers were German. 500 officers born in Germany.

The Germania Orchestra became the New York Philharmonic Orchestra..

Germany 6,800,000

Italy 5,100,000

Gr. Britain 4,760,000

Ireland 4,700,000

Austro-Hun. 4,200,000

Soviet 3,300,000

Switzerland 340,000

One third of those from Austro-Hungary were Germanic, 74% of the Swiss were Germanic, and according to the 1920 census 116,000 of the Russians were Germanic which brings the total to 8,540,000.
