What is the GRO?

General Register Office

Official information on births, adoptions, marriages, civil partnerships and deaths in England and Wales

- The General Register Office was established in 1837 as the official repository of all births, marriages and deaths in England and Wales. It also includes events recorded abroad.
- Before July 1st of that year, records had been legally kept, although with varying detail, in the Parish Registers.
- After the Registration Act was passed, local registrars recorded the events and sent a copy to London.
- It was not compulsory to register events until 1874, after which fines were imposed within 6 weeks of the event for non-compliance.
- Later records may include civil partnerships and adopted children.

How do I find the GRO indexes?

- The indexes are free to access online on the GRO (partial) or the FreeReg sites.

- You can access the microfiche records in these libraries (in England). These places have the only complete copies of the full sets of index reference numbers:

Library of Birmingham; Bridgend Local and Family History Centre; City of Westminster Archives Centre; Manchester Central Library; Newcastle City Library; Plymouth Central Library; The British Library

- These libraries and centers are online and can help you order copies of the certificates.
- Indexes from the GRO can also be found at FreeGenealogy, FindMyPast, Ancestry,
 FamilySearch, MyHeritage, The Genealogist, etc. Local British FamilySearch centers and local register offices may hold partial sets on microfiche or CD-ROM.

What information is on the records?

- Birth certificate: Date and place of birth; name and residence of mother; sometimes maiden name; name and occupation of father
- Marriage certificate: Full names of both parties; occupations; residences; date and place; names and occupations of fathers (before May 2021).
- Death certificate: Date of death; age, occupation; final residence; cause of death; name and relationship of informant

Information contained on a birth, marriage, civil partnership or death certificate

- 1. Details contained on a full birth certificate include:
- . Name, date and place of birth.
- Father's name (if given at time of registration), place of birth and occupation.
- Mother's name, place of birth, maiden surname and, after 1984, occupation.

Please note that registrations made before 1969 do not include details of the parents' place of birth and mother's occupation.

- Details contained on a marriage certificate prior to 4th May 2021 include:
- Date and place of marriage.
- · Name, age and marital status/condition of the parties.
- Occupation and usual address.
- Name and occupation of each party's father.
- · Names of the witnesses.
- Name of the person who solemnised the marriage.
 - Details contained on a marriage certificate after 4th May 2021 include:
- · Date and place of marriage.
- Name, date of birth and marital status/condition of the parties.
- Occupation and usual address.
- Name of each party's mother/father/parent (up to 4 entries per party).
- · Names of the witnesses.
- Name of the person who solemnised the marriage
 - 4. Details contained on a civil partnership certificate include:
- Date and place of civil partnership.
- . Name, date of birth and marital status/condition of the parties.
- Occupation and usual address.
- Name of each party's mother/father/parent (up to 4 entries per party).
- Names of the witnesses.
- Name of the person who performed the civil ceremony
 - 5. Details contained on a death certificate include:
- Name, date and place of death.
- Date and place of birth (before 1969 a certificate only showed age of deceased).
- · Occupation and usual address.
- · Cause of death.
- The person who gave information for the death registration.

What information is in the index?

- The year of the event
- The quarter of the event
- The district where the event was registered
- The volume and page number of the index entry

How do I order a certificate?

- Use the ordering system online (cheapest and easiest).
- Find the GRO index reference number (Year, Quarter, District, Volume and Page).
- Fill out the form.
- Pay the fee of 11 pounds. The certificate will be sent 4 days after you apply.
- You can pay 3 pounds for each search, if you don't have the reference number. That takes 15 days.
- Priority service is 35 pounds.

Anything else I need to know?

- You can also order a PDF version or the Online view digital image in JPEG format.
- The availability of certificates include birth registration records over 100 years old and deaths from 1837 to 1957.
- No marriage certificates have been indexed or digitized on the GRO. You can order certificates; however,
 there may be privacy laws applicable (index is 1837 to 1983 on BMD).
- Birth indexes have been digitized on the GRO site from 1837 until 1934. Then from 1984 to 2021.
- Death indexes have been digitized on the GRO site from 1837 until 1957. Then from 1984 to 2021.
- You can fill the gap by using the FreeBMD indexes.



General Guidelines for searching when you don't have exact info

- Use 2 years as the range.
- Use more than one spelling.
- Start with only the first name, then add full middle name
- For births, start with no mother or district.

General Guidelines for searching when you don't have exact info, cont.

- Check through the results.
- Narrow by district. If you aren't certain of the district, start with the one you think it is and work outward.






General Guidelines is searching when you don't have exact info cont.

- Add the mother's maiden name, possible. Add middle names.
- Change from exact match on the names to other options if you don't find what you are looking for.
- A hyphen for the mother's name may mean an illegitimate birth.






General Guidelines for searching when you don't have exact info, cont.

- Move up or down the year range by 4 years at a time.
- The results are listed in order by year and quarter.
- To search for all the children of a mother, type the last name, the mother's maiden name, the sex, and the district, if known. Move up the range, starting with the marriage date, at least 25-30 years or until her death.
- Change the sex and come back down the year range.
- Use the name options or different spellings if you don't immediately find the answer.

- Who are you searching for? - The same basic principles apply when searching the death index.
- Start with the last known living age and move up by 4 years at a time.
 Change the death range as you go.
- It's easiest to use the 5-year death age range unless you know the exact year of death.





FreeReg.org provides free internet searches of baptism, marriage, and burial records. We are transcribing records from parish registers, non-conformist records and other relevant sources in the UK.









Welcome to FreeBMD.

FreeBMD is an ongoing project, the aim of which is to transcribe the Civil Registration index of births, marriages and deaths for England and Wales, and to provide free Internet access to the transcribed records. It is a part of the Free UK Genealogy family, which also includes FreeCEN (Census data) and FreeREG (Parish Registers). To search the records that have so far been transcribed by FreeBMD click on the Search button below.

The recording of births, marriages and deaths was started in 1837 and is one of the most significant resources for genealogical research. The transcribing of the records is carried out by teams of dedicated volunteers and contains index information for the period 1837-1997, BUT WE HAVE NOT YET TRANSCRIBED THE WHOLE PERIOD. A breakdown by event and year can be viewed here.

FreeBMD is exactly that - FREE. We do not make any charge whatsoever for use of the site and we never ask for credit card details to do a search. FreeBMD is a registered charity and our objective is to provide free online access to the GRO Index. However, FreeBMD costs money to run and if you would like to make a donation, by PayPal or other methods, please see here.

Check type of record.

Fill in names needed as known.

Fill in dates as known.

Fill in date range years (2-5 years, all quarters).

Check options boxes.

Click Find.

Click Count to see only the number of records found.

Click Reset to start a new search (query).

Some guidelines:

- All fields are optional but add only as much information as you need. The more information, the fewer results. Add information to narrow the results. Large numbers of results may result in getting timed out.
- Search by location (county) when necessary. Be careful with districts. Use the GRO Registration District Book for applicable dates (link above) or
 - https://www.ukbmd.org.uk/reg/districts/index.ht ml.
 - Use a date range of about 2-5 years (normally) from March quarter to December quarter. Births could be registered several months after birthdate, and deaths even longer.

Some more guidelines:

- You can search for all three record types at once, but normally it works better to limit search to one type.
- Enter first name and middle name(s) (when needed) on same line. Do not use periods after initials.
- Use a wildcard with * for any number of characters,? for one character.
- Mother's maiden name available after 1911.

Tips for Finding Marriages

- TIP 1: Prior to 1875, the registration of an event was not compulsory and therefore some were missed.
- TIP 2: Marriages sometimes took place after the birth of the first child. Widening the timescale searched may help.
- TIP 3: A marriage might have taken place outside of England and Wales, e.g. Scotland.
- TIP 4: The bride may have been married more than once – try looking under the name of the groom instead.
- TIP 5: There may never have been a marriage.
 Couples often lived together as man and wife because divorce was rare and expensive. Some did not remarry after their spouse died.


